Unbeknownst to them, their actions had awakened a malevolent entity that lurked in the shadows.

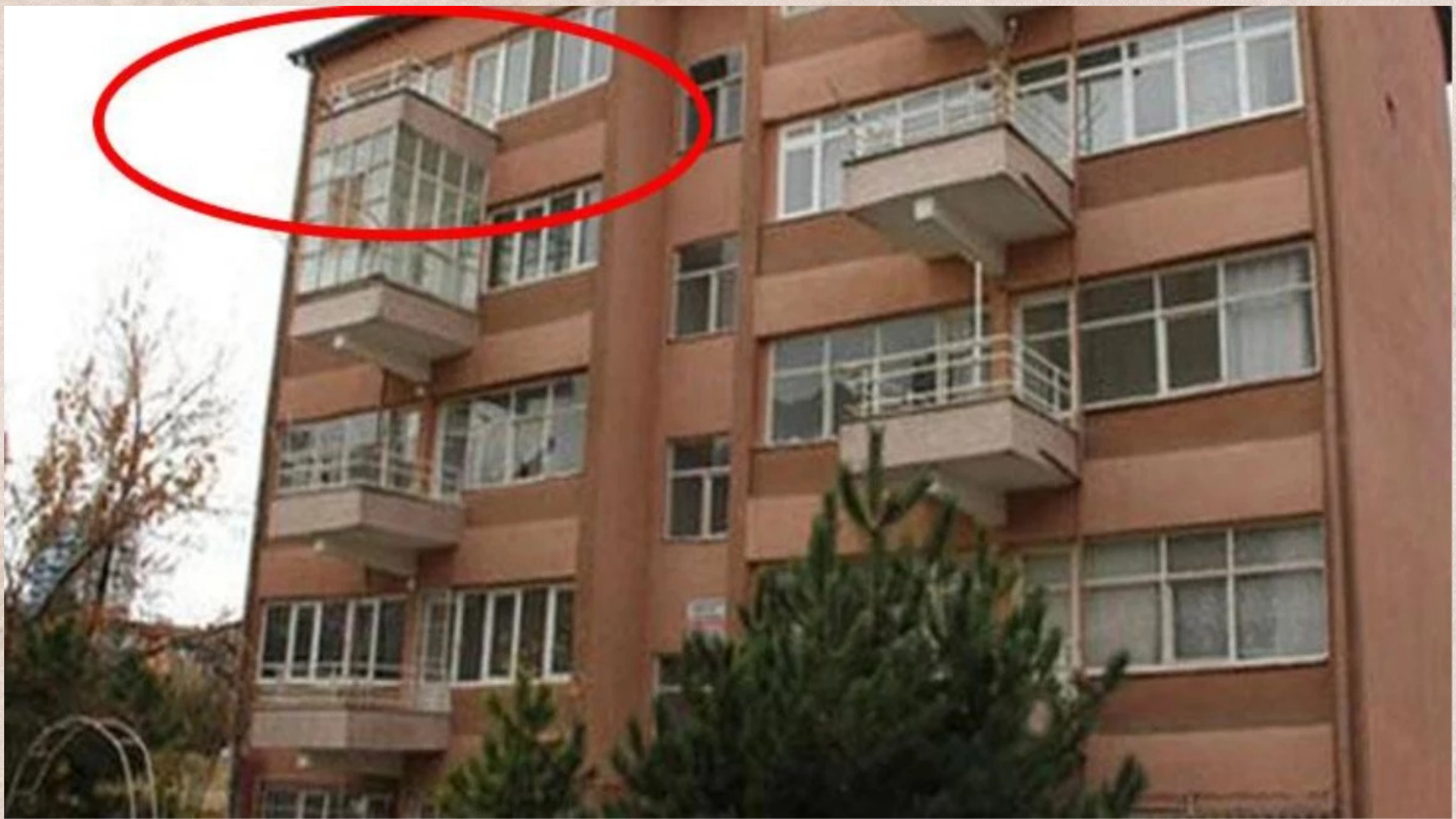

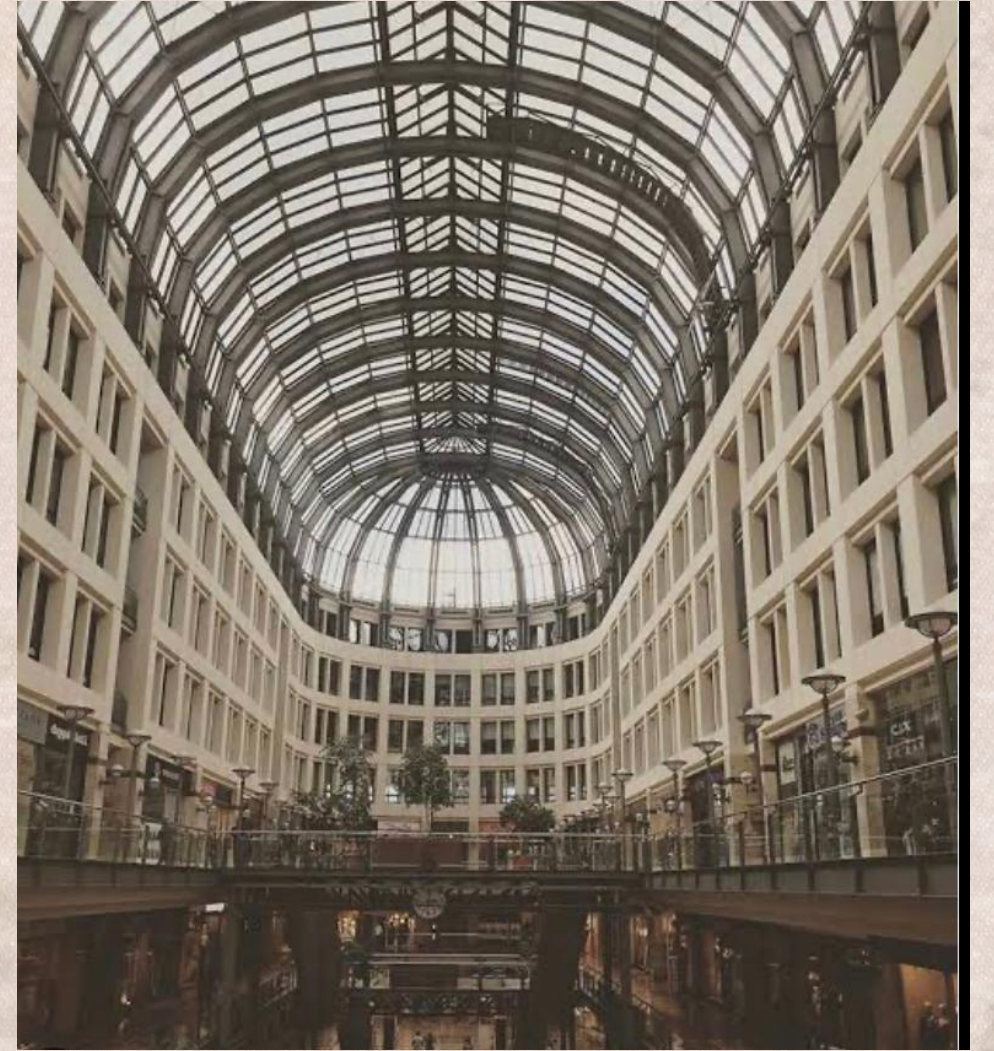
