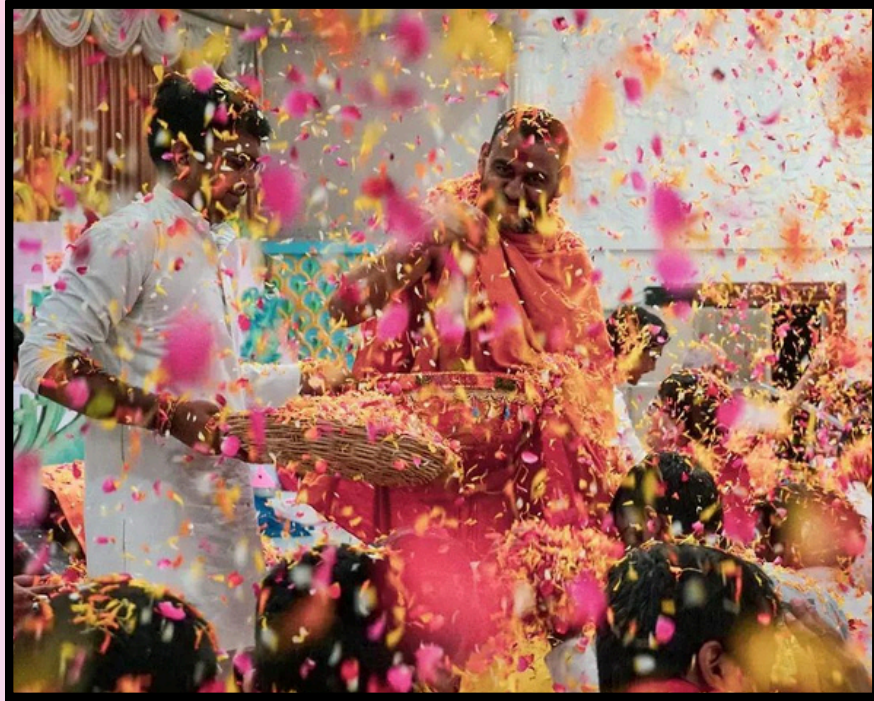

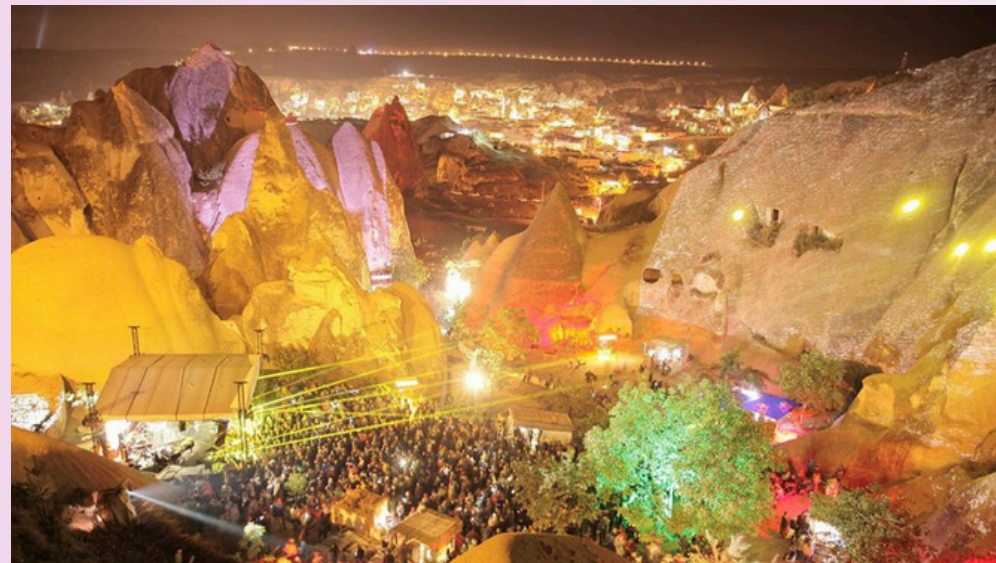




Cappadox Festival



It is a festival that has been celebrated in May since 2015 and offers participants great concerts, shows and cultural and artistic events.



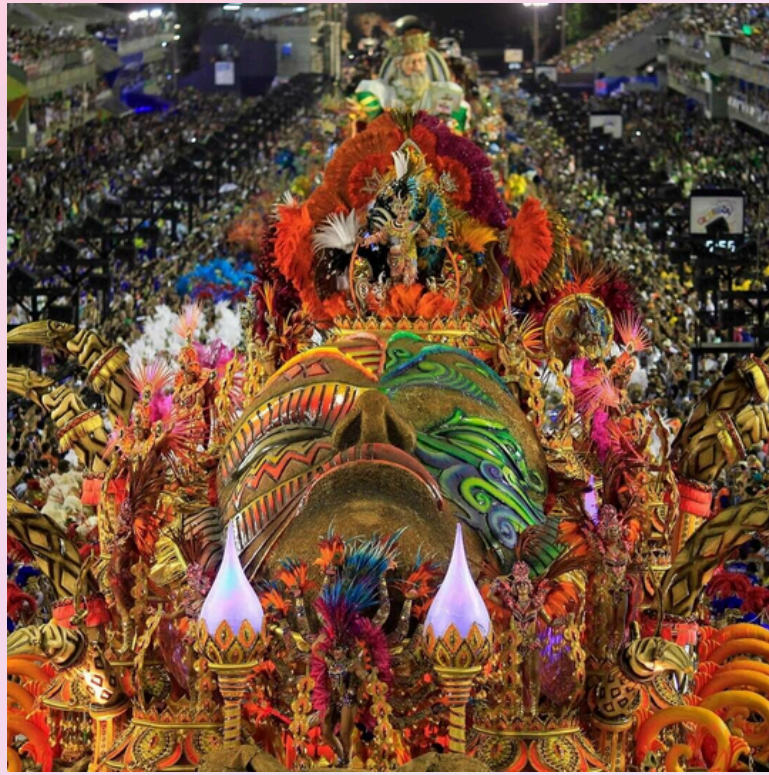
