- •The Halo Effect: If someone appears wealthy, the brain automatically assigns them credibility, competence, and power.
- •Authority Bias: People instinctively trust those who project confidence. Leviev never hesitated, never second-guessed, never broke character.
- Social Proof: Humans look to others for validation. Leviev created a network of fake news articles, luxury displays, and staged connections to eliminate doubt before it even formed.

He did not need to convince anyone, what he simply did was creating a scenario where questioning him felt irrational.

### **Preliminary Overview**

Deception is not chance but strategy, targeting trust: the most exploitable human vulnerability.

Simon Leviev did not simply defraud. He engineered control. His manipulation was systematic, exploiting victims both financially and emotionally through calculated psychological tactics.

Unlike impulsive fraudsters, Leviev operated with precision, devoid of genuine emotion. His crimes expose the fragility of trust, showing how deception thrives when victims unknowingly facilitate their own downfall.

This forensic analysis asks: Is it deception if the deceived hand over the tools of their own ruin?

### How He Broke Them Without Force

Leviev's fraud was not theft, it was behavioral conditioning. His victims were not tricked into giving. They were programmed to.

- •Attachment Engineering: Love bombing was not romance. It was neurological manipulation. Overwhelming displays of affection flood the brain with oxytocin, building attachment before logic can intervene.
- •Crisis Induction: Manufactured emergencies shut down rational thinking. Stress forces the brain into survival mode. The faster Leviev pushed, the less time his victims had to process reality.
- •Intermittent Reinforcement; Love, panic, reward, withdrawal. A cycle designed to create dependency. It is the same principle that keeps gamblers addicted. The unpredictability becomes the hook.

By the time his victims realized the truth, it was not just their money that was gone, it was something worse, much worse: it was their ability to trust their own instincts.

### Unmasking: The Psychopath Behind the Facade

Leviev is not impulsive, he is solely deliberate, aligning almost flawlessly with the diagnostic criteria outlined in the DSM-5 for Cluster B Personality Disorders.

- •Antisocial Personality Disorder (ASPD): Pathological lying, total absence of remorse, emotional detachment.
- Narcissistic Personality Disorder (NPD): Grandiosity, entitlement, an insatiable need for validation.
- ·Machiavellianism (also known as the Dark Triad): Extreme manipulation, strategic deception, lack of moral restraint.

Leviev does not experience regret because, in his mind, he never did anything wrong. His victims were not victims, they were assets to be extracted. His crimes were not reckless, they were calculated psychological dissections.

### Reasoning: A Man Walked Free, Not the Last One That Will

The legal system does not know what to do with men like Leviev.

He did not forge documents, he forged trust. He did not steal, he conditioned his victims to give. His deception did not violate contracts, it rewrote reality.

Courts punish tangible theft, but psychological fraud leaves no fingerprints. The law was written for criminals who take by force, not for those who manipulate their victims into surrendering everything willingly.

Leviev did not need real wealth, only the illusion of it. The next will not even need that.

In an era where perception is reality, fraud is not an art, but practical science & craftsmanship.







### **Simon: A Serial Scammer**

A man scammed a lot of woman using a dating app. Scammer's name is Simon Leviev who presented himself as the owner of an international diamond company on the dating app Tinder.
