BUDGET OF EXPENSIVE SPORTS





Also ,tennis is shaping the fashion industry. For example, Lacoste used to be just a sport brand which makes tennis t-shirts but then their designs became more popular among people not involved in the sports. At the beginning of the famous tennis matches (Wimbledon), they organize a fashion show by using sponsors clothes, sports equipments etc. and with these sponsor's, tennis match budget is getting bigger and it's good for both tennis players and sponsor brands. Tennis players earns thousands of dollars by collaborating with brands.

Tennis match tickets may be really expensive because of tournament type. For example, Grand Slam Final, Wimbledon etc. If we get more specific for the men's singles final at the US Open, one report said the average resale ticket price is about \$4,058, with the most expensive reaching over \$45,000, so what makes these prices high? It depends on where your seat is , hospitality/ VIP seats, if famous players are going to play there will be absolute ticket fee rising. For example, in 2025 in US Open Men's Singles Plan (Alcaraz vs Sinner) tournament had pushed record for high selling. Highest-fee sold ticket was \$45,561 and the average ticket was \$4,058.






There is gossip, sneaky deals, and even black market tickets that cost more than a

2020 U.S. Doping Scandal

In 2020, 27 people (trainers, veterinarians, drug suppliers) were indicted for administering performance-enhancing or pain-masking drugs to racehorses, including dangers like "blood builders," "red acid," etc.

Horses died in some cases, and there were claims of abuse of animals.



"Gay Future" Horse-Switching Fraud

The plan: A trainer and syndicate attempted to substitute a promising horse for a lesser one (or vice versa) so that betting odds would be favourable. The "imposter" worked until the scheme unraveled.



Horse Death Transport Abuse

John "Shark" Hanlon had his licence suspended after a dead horse was transported uncovered on a public road, visibly. This raised questions about respect, welfare, and public image.





2002 Breeders' Cup Betting Scandal

A group used inside information and tampered with the betting system to alter tickets after several races, so that a ticket would win in a way it shouldn't. Key players were caught, convicted of wire fraud and money laundering.

The new LIV Golf league, supported by Saudi Arabia, created a big fight in the golf world. Many players left the PGA Tour for LIV Golf, and fans were divided. The two sides later tried to make a deal to work together.
