


Shivers the Stray Cat





Archie.




Archie used to have an owner. That's why he refused to be friends with street cats. He was acting uppity and bullying other cats.




On a normal sunny school day, everybody was playing outside and enjoying the good weather. Jasper was late but Shivers and Coco joined their friends in the garden.




At first everything was fine until when Archie started to annoy coco with throwing ball to his head, saying things like "You are so bad at this game."




Coco was humiliated and expected Shivers to support him and speak up but Shivers couldn't say anything and watched him getting bullied.




Coco left crying Shivers

for his friend.




Next day, Coco didn't manage to come but Shiver and Jasper were together in school. Shiver mentioned Jasper about what Archie did in the previous day.

Jasper asked him "Why didn't you do anything when he needed you the most?" Shivers felt so regretful and so bad for his friend.




Jasper was a clever cat

fix the situation.




Next day all three of them were at school. It was obvious from Coco's face that he was upset. His friends tried to cheer him up but it was all for nothing.




Coco wasn't talking to Shivers. He asked Coco "Why are you not talking to me?" because everything can be solved by communication.




Later that day, while they


